

Persian Ghazal



The Ghazal is the leading medium for lyrical expression not only in the classical Persian tradition, but also in Arabic, Turkish, and Urdu poetic traditions. We will read and discuss Ghazals by such well-known poets as Rumi (d. 1273), Amir Khusraw (d. 1325), and Hafiz (d. 1390), figures whose poetry has inspired global audiences well beyond Persian and the cultural geography to which they belonged.

Ultimately, Persian 455 is taught as a language course in which only your understanding and production of language will be assessed.
